

Faculty can request from IT helpdesk a new instructor kit with a receiver. Faculty have two options (or a combination) for students to participate with clickers.

For faculty who prohibit the use of mobile devices, the first option is to have students purchase Turning Point physical clickers directly from the company at the following address:

Once entering the store, students will be prompted to enter UC Hastings school code. Our school code is **uCH2** . Once they have entered the school code they will have 2 bundle choices as follows:

1. One Year Turning Account student license (**Price: \$40.00**)
- or
2. Four Year Turning Account student license (**Price: \$55.00**)

Turning Point will directly handle shipping the clickers to students and supporting any issues or malfunctions.

The second option involves using a digital clicker with a mobile device. IT has purchased 200 digital licenses that can be distributed to students on a first come, first serve basis. In order to take advantage of this, students can navigate to this address to receive their license...
