THE ROLE

This is a one-year position. Under the direction and supervision of the Academic Dean and as part of the Institute for Innovation Law, the Visiting Assistant Professor will study privacy programs at other institutions, develop privacy programming for UC Hastings, both for teaching students and to support startups in the local ecosystem, and teach courses or guest lectures.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Typical duties and responsibilities consist of, but are not limited to, the following:

- Teaching classes as determined by the Academic Dean;
- Reviewing and analyzing privacy programs at other institutions;
- Developing privacy programming for UC Hastings for teaching students and to support startups in the local ecosystem; and
- Collaborate with Institute for Innovation Law and LexLab, two UC Hastings programs.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- Juris Doctor Degree from an ABA-accredited law school;
- Relevant substantive experience pertaining to privacy law and education;
- Program and course development experience, preferably in the law school setting.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES.

- Knowledge of privacy law;
- Strong legal writing, research, and analysis skills;
- Strong organizational skills for tracking data and program materials (electronic and hard copy);
- Demonstrated ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with faculty, alumni, staff, and students; and
- Program management and teaching skills.
- As with many startups, the Institute offices are set up as an open, cooperative workspace, rather than individual offices. The Visiting Assistant Professor must be comfortable with that working environment.
