THE ROLE

Under general direction of the manager, Facilities Operations, the Building Maintenance Worker independently performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks in support of the maintenance, repair and renovation of the College's physical systems, buildings and grounds displaying plumbing, mechanical, carpentry and electrical skills.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Typical duties and responsibilities consist of, but are not limited to, the following:

- Prepares and paints walls, doors and related surfaces;
- Repairs and/or replaces ceiling and wall tiles, floor carpet and tiles;
- Installs and repairs furniture, plumbing and electrical fixtures and appliances;
- Repairs and replace doors door hardware such as hinges, latches, locks and keys;
- Install electrical and mechanical equipment;
- Tests fire pumps and generators;
- Identify and report maintenance deficiencies on a routine basis and initiates documentation required to assure correction;
- Moves furniture, appliances and equipment using appropriate equipment;
- Removes graffiti;
- Troubleshoot, repair and perform preventative maintenance of mechanical and electrical equipment;
- Performs routine energy management system checks and adjustments;
- Operates motor vehicle in picking up supplies from vendors;
- Perform other related tasks as assigned;
- Replace lamps, ballast and light fixtures.

REQUIREMENTS

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

- Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree preferred;
- Completion of a trade curriculum in one or more of the major disciplines (carpentry, electrical, plumbing or mechanical) preferred;
- A minimum of five years of related work experience independently performing skilled and semi-skilled building maintenance work in the fields of plumbing, carpentry, electrical, painting, mechanical and HVAC controls and maintenance.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES.

- Communicate effectively both orally and in writing;
- Read and understand specifications, diagrams and work orders;
- Use appropriate hand and power tools in an efficient, safe and effective manner;
- Must be a self-starter with demonstrated dependability and must also work well as a team member;
- Independently perform skilled and semi-skilled tasks in plumbing, electrical, mechanical and carpentry;
- Perform basic arithmetic calculations to calculate work areas and materials;
- Ability to stand, climb, stoop, push, pull and crouch for extended periods of time, as required to complete assigned tasks;
- Must be able to lift items weighing up to 70 pounds;
- Must be able to push and pull heavy objects;
- Must have knowledge of methods, materials, tools and equipment necessary to proficiently perform assigned diversified maintenance;
- Must have knowledge of energy management systems and lighting control;
- Possession of a valid California Driver's License preferred.
