Instructions

It has been my great honor to teach you Civil Procedure.

Please select two of three fact patterns for the essay questions. The material shown in *italics* has already been shared with you, verbatim. You have a choice for two reasons. First, you may play to your strengths in terms of your knowledge. Second, it is possible you will be affected by a hypothetical fact pattern, unduly and unfairly, even though it is merely a fictional example; the idea is to allow you to avoid such an adverse effect. Note that Fact Pattern 2 involves the use of an illegal drug, meth; and Fact Pattern 3 involves an alleged illicit sexual relationship.

Please do all of the multiple choice questions. Select the best answer. There is no penalty for incorrect answers. You would be well served by starting with the multiple choice section. The multiple choice section will be weighted as equivalent to one essay question.

If you have any concerns about any aspect of the exam, e.g., if you believe there is a typographical error that is significant, please write a note in brackets. (Square brackets such as between these double quotation marks: “[]”). It will be evaluated. If any multiple choice question turns out to be problematic (e.g., an inverse correlation for that problem in particular against the results in general), it will be reviewed, and, if appropriate, discarded.

These instructions have been distributed in advance, also verbatim. Excerpts from the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure (FRCP) and 28 U.S.C. are appended. The syllabus defined “close book” as follows.

“Closed book” is a defined term. It excludes everything except a copy of the FRCP (text only), which will be provided to you. “Everything” admits of no exceptions.
