In any case where you need further facts, indicate what sort of facts you want to know and what difference they would make in the answer to the question. **Consider alternative solutions of a non-frivolous nature, even if you believe that the problem can be properly resolved without reaching a particular issue.** Suggested time: Essay question one: 60 minute
Essay question two: 90 minutes.
