Grand Theft 154 McAllister Street

On June 13, 2014 at approximately 12:00 pm it was reported to Hastings Public Safety Department by the San Francisco Police Department that an unknown suspect stole a bicycle that was locked to a parking meter located approximately at 154 McAllister Street. It was later confirmed through surveillance video that the suspect committed the theft at approximately 11:10 am.

Suspect Description:

White male adult, glasses, hooded sweatshirt, wearing a backpack.

Bicycle Description:

Green colored bamboo bicycle.

Bicycle Safety Tips

- Always lock your bike's frame and wheels with a high-quality, modern U-lock (with a disc/flat key).
- Remove all detachable items like bags, helmet and take them with you.
- Lock to a firmly affixed (bolts covered in concrete) pole.
- Set alarm or anti-theft device.
