Petty Theft

100 McAllister Street

On Saturday, June 14, 2014, it was reported to UC Hastings Public Safety Department that from approximately 12pm-3pm a UC Hastings student left their clothing unattended in the 100 McAllister Street residential facility laundry room for a short period of time and returned to find articles missing.

This incident is currently under investigation.
