## ***Aggravated Assault w/Knife McAllister Street & Hyde Street***

On Monday, June 23, 2014 at approximately 8:10 pm a UC Hastings DPS officer saw a stabbing taking place in front of 200 McAllister Street. DPS responded and found a victim was stabbed by an unknown suspect in a group of individuals that all fled the scene westbound on foot via McAllister Street. Hastings Officer detained one suspect. SFPD was driving by and saw Hastings officer in a foot chase and detained one suspect. Two suspects were detained and one suspect is still at large. EMS also responded and the victim was transported to a nearby hospital. No one from the Hastings community was involved.

### **Suspect(s) Description:**

The suspect still at large is a black adult male, wearing black hoodie and dark jeans.

This incident is currently under investigation by the San Francisco Police Department.
