Robbery Attempt 350-399 Golden Gate Avenue

On July 4, 2014 at approximately 1:50 pm, A UC Hastings Public Safety Officer responded to a report of a fight on the 350-399 block of Golden Gate Avenue. Two subjects were observed in an altercation in the back of a pickup truck. The owner of the vehicle was attempting to detain a suspect that he caught breaking into his vehicle and had his car stereo, and sunglasses in his possession. The suspect was arrested by UCHDPS and turned over to responding San Francisco Police Officers for attempted robbery and for auto boosting/stripping and transported to county jail.

This incident is currently under investigation by the San Francisco Police Department. Robbery Safety Tips:

- If you are faced with demands for your money or property, especially from an armed subject, comply with their demands for the sake of your safety.
- Follow the robber's commands, but do not volunteer help.
- Be observant and plan to be a good witness.
- Try to note the robber's method of escape and direction of travel.
