## *Petty Theft 100 McAllister Street*

On February 11, 2014 at approximately 7:30 pm a Hastings student reported their motorcycle helmet, keys and pair of gloves were stolen. The student left their motorcycle parked on the street with keys left in keyhole of lock box. Unknown suspect took key and contents of lock box, which included motorcycle helmet and pair of gloves. Suspect remains unknown no physical description.

### **Personal Safety Tips**

- Always lock your bike's frame and wheels with a high-quality, modern U-lock (with a disc/flat key).
- Remove all detachable items like bags, helmet and take them with you.
- Lock to a firmly affixed (bolts covered in concrete) pole.
- Set alarm or anti-theft device.
