Vandalism / Theft From Locked Auto 100-150 McAllister Street

On Tuesday, February 25, 2014 at approximately 9:47 am, it was reported to Hastings Public Safety Department that a vandalism/theft from locked auto occurred in front of 136 McAllister Street at approximately 5:18am. Surveillance footage of the area revealed an unknown suspect removing a bicycle from the vehicle and fled eastbound on McAllister Street toward Market Street.

Suspect Description:

Unknown light skinned male wearing a gray hooded sweatshirt, dark colored shirt and pants, running shoes and carrying a dark colored backpack.

Vehicle Description:

Black Suzuki XL7
