Robbery ***100 block of McAllister Street***

On April 29, 2014 at approximately 9:00 am it was reported to Hastings Public Safety Department that an unknown suspect was arrested and taken into custody by San Francisco Police Department near the 100 McAllister Street building. It was later confirmed that the suspect committed a robbery, vehicle burglary and was found in possession of burglary tools. The suspect gained entry into a parked vehicle near the 100 McAllister street building and when the owner of the vehicle returned a confrontation ensued. The suspect attempted to flee northbound onto Leavenworth Street but was apprehended.

Suspect Description:

Asian male adult, black jacket, green pants, orange backpack strapped across chest.

Robbery Safety Tips:

- If you are faced with demands for your money or property, especially from an armed subject, comply with their demands for the sake of your safety.
- Follow the robber's commands, but do not volunteer help.
- Be observant and plan to be a good witness.
- Try to note the robber's method of escape and direction of travel.
