Theft From Auto 100-198 McAllister Street

On Sunday, May 4, 2014 at approximately 6:15 am, UC Hastings Public Safety Department observed an unknown suspect break into a rear storage compartment of a parked motorcycle near the 100 McAllister Street building, then attempted to break into a vehicle's trunk from inside the parked vehicle that already had a shattered window located near 198 McAllister Street. San Francisco Police were contacted and the suspect was arrested and taken into custody. Surveillance footage of the area captured the incident.

Suspect Description:

Hispanic male adult, facial hair, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt and black pants.

Auto Burglary Prevention Tips
