May 11th 2014

Assault w/Firearm Golden Gate Avenue & Hyde Street

On Sunday, May 11, 2014 at approximately 12:53 am a shooting took place at the intersection of Hyde Street and Golden Gate Avenue. Two victims were shot by an unknown suspect that fled the scene in a vehicle. SFPD responded to the location and EMS responded. Victims were transported to a nearby hospital.

Suspect Description:

Unknown adult male, large build, approx 6ft, white baseball cap, black hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans, and black shoes.

Suspect Vehicle Description:

Honda Accord 4 dr, light green, late 90's or early 2000 model.
