January 8th 2013

211-Robbery/245-Assault with Instrument other than Firearm – McAllister / Leavenworth Intersection

On Tuesday, January 8, 2013 at approximately 8:30pm, a member of the public reported to the San Francisco Police Department that he was walking eastbound on McAllister Street and when he reached Leavenworth Street four unknown men attacked him from behind and knocked him to the ground. The suspects struck him repeatedly with feet and hands. The victim was robbed of his cellular phone.

The victim described the suspect(s) with the following information:

Four black male adults wearing black pants, and black hooded sweatshirts. One of the suspects was described as wearing a blue hooded sweatshirt.

Surveillance footage was able to capture footage of the incident, however the suspects are seen fleeing eastbound on McAllister Street and southbound onto Market Street.

Currently, robbery of cellular phones on the street in San Francisco is a growing crime.
