Sexual Battery –Hyde/McAllister Street

On April 9, 2013 at approximately 11:56 am it was reported to the Office of Public Safety that An unknown subject committed a sexual battery on a UC Hastings female employee. The victim reported that the subject slapped her on her buttock as she was walking up the stairs to the 198 McAllister Street building.

The victim positively identified the male subject as he was southbound on Hyde Street.

Several witnesses to the subject's behavior confirmed that the subject was involved in several batteries on females on Hyde Street.

The subject was arrested by Public Safety Officers and San Francisco Police Officers took custody of the subject.

If you are the victim of a sexual battery the following are some safety tips that may prove helpful:

- Get to a safe place as soon as you can.
- Be aware of your surroundings
- Report the incident to the nearest law enforcement officer or dial 9-1-1
- If you are walking alone, try to have a whistle with you. If you find yourself in danger, blow the whistle to attract attention for help

If you observe any suspicious activity on or around campus, please report it to Campus Public Safety immediately, or once you are in a safe location. For emergency or in-progress incidents, dial 9-1-1 and/or report it to the Public Safety Department.
