Petty Theft – 198 McAllister Street

On April 10, 2013 at approximately 6:45pm it was reported to the Office of Public Safety that a student's wallet was missing. The wallet was returned to the lost and found. The student stated she had left her wallet and cell phone in the Gold Reading Room women's restroom. Student checked her wallet and found her cash, bankcards and a major credit card inside, she noticed one major credit card was missing. The wallet was found inside the Gold Reading Room, not inside the women's restroom. Her cell phone was not found.

Value: approximately \$650.00 USD

No suspects have been identified at this time.
