Vandalism of Vehicles 100-150 block of McAllister Street

On Sunday, April 14, 2013, at approximately 8:30 am, the 100 McAllister Street Hastings residential building security guard contacted UC Hastings Public Safety and reported that there were two vehicles that had their passenger side windows broken. The vehicles were parked on the 100-150 block of McAllister Street. Two vehicles were observed to have had their front passenger side windows broken.

Vehicle Descriptions:

(Vehicle#1) 2002 White Acura SZ

(Vehicle#2) 2010 Red Honda Fit

The owner of (Veh#1) was identified as a non Hastings community member, and stated that nothing was missing from his vehicle. The victim advised that he parked his vehicle in that location at approximately 4:00 am. The owner of (Veh#2) was not contacted.

Surveillance video footage was reviewed of the area and captured images of two subjects loitering in the area of the vehicles from approximately 0620-0627 hours.

Subject Description:

Subject #1: An unknown male adult, grey hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans.

Subject #2: An unknown female, black hooded sweatshirt, and light colored pants.

Other noteworthy features: the subjects had a white poodle with them.

The two subjects were last seen walking east bound on McAllister Street.
