Vandalism of Vehicle 50 block of Hyde Street

On Sunday, April 14, 2013, at approximately 1:15 pm, A UC Hastings Student reported to the Department of Public Safety that their vehicle was vandalized on the 50 block of Hyde Street. The vehicle appeared to have had its passenger side mirror intentionally broken off and left on the sidewalk. The incident occurred between the hours of 9:00am -12:00pm.

Vehicle Description:

2001 Burgundy Honda Civic 4 door

Surveillance video footage was reviewed and was unable to positively identify any persons involved.

Vandalism Crime Prevention Tips

- DO NOT approach or attempt to apprehend the vandal.
- Get a good description of the vandal(s) and their vehicle(s).
- Park your car in well-lit areas in designated parking spaces.
