Petty Larceny/Theft – 200 McAllister Street

On April 24, 2013 at approximately 9:05 am a UC Hastings student reported to the Office of Public Safety that their cellular phone was stolen from a restroom on the 4th floor of 200 McAllister Street building on April 18, 2013 at approximately 3:30 pm. The victim stated that they placed the phone on a countertop and forgot the phone and returned 40 minutes later to find that it was missing.

The value of the phone is approximately \$300 and is described as a black iPhone 4s.

No suspects have been identified at this time.

The phone was reported activated with another phone company as of April 21, 2013.

- Do not leave possessions unattended at any time. This is to include classrooms the Law Library, and common areas.
