Robbery – 200 McAllister/Muni Bus

On Wednesday, April 24, 2013 at approximately 4:12pm, a robbery occurred on the #5 Muni Bus in front of 200 McAllister Street bus stop. Unknown male suspect grabbed the victim's cell phone from her hand and ran off the bus.

The victim described the suspect with the following information:

The suspect was described as a black male juvenile, approximately 12-15 years of age, 5'0", 120 lbs. wearing a blue top, dark colored jeans, blue hat, carrying a basketball. The subject was last observed fleeing on foot southbound onto Hyde Street. Surveillance footage of the incident was captured and submitted to the San Francisco Police Department.

Personal Robbery Safety Tips:

- Exercise your peripheral vision at all times, and be aware of your surroundings 360 degrees around you.
- If you are faced with demands for your money or property, especially from an armed subject, comply with their demands for the sake of your safety.
- Follow the robber's commands, but do not volunteer help.
- Be observant and plan to be a good witness.
- Try to note the robber's method of escape and direction of travel.
