



# CRIME ALERT

*April 26, 2013*

## ***Burglary – 200 McAllister Street***

On Friday, April 26, 2013 at approximately 0800 hours, it was reported to UC Hastings Public Safety Department that a bicycle may have been stolen from the bicycle enclosure located at 200 McAllister Street. Evidence that the enclosure was broken into indicated entry was made in order to commit a theft.

This incident is currently under investigation.

Surveillance footage of the incident was captured.

### Suspect Description:

Unknown male adult, black pants, black hooded jacket, baseball hat

### Possible Stolen Bicycle Description:

Dark Colored Mountain style bicycle locked with cable style lock and U-Lock attached.

The bicycle owner has not yet been identified.

### **Burglary Prevention Tips**

- Keep a record of model and serial numbers for your valuables.
- Use a highly-rated lock of any design, or heavy duty U-lock that cannot be defeated with a car jack; use two different kinds of locks; lock tires to frame.
- If you observe any suspicious activity on or around campus please report it to Campus Public Safety immediately at 565-4611 or by picking up a "Red" phone, or once you are in a safe location.

If you are the victim of a burglary on the UC Hastings Campus, please report it to Hastings Public Safety Department for a report, and then to San Francisco Police Department for a report.
