# CRIME ALERT

*May 12, 2013*

## ***Robbery – 300 block of Golden Gate Avenue***

On May 12, 2013 at approximately 2345 hours (11:45pm) The San Francisco Police Department advised the Office of Public Safety that a robbery occurred on the 300 block of Golden Gate Avenue.

At 2241 hours (10:41pm) a member of the public was robbed of his cell phone. The victim was on the northwest corner of Golden Gate Avenue and Hyde Street, when several suspects pushed the victim to the ground and grabbed the cell phone out of the victim's hand. San Francisco Police Department responded and handled the investigation. No suspect has been arrested at this time.

### **Suspects Description:**

One of the subjects was described as a hispanic male adult wearing a grey shirt. Other suspects were not identified.
