May 19, 2013 Theft From Vehicle Leavenworth Street

On Sunday, May 19, 2013, at approximately 8:50 pm, a victim from the public reported his car was broken into on Leavenworth Street between McAllister Street and Golden Gate Ave. Victim parked his car on May 18, 2013 between 5:30 pm and 6:45 pm. A black backpack containing art supplies, leather briefcase containing artwork, ipad 2-retina screen and black Logitech keyboard was stolen from the vehicle.

No surveillance footage.
