Robbery w/knife – 300 Block of Golden Gate Avenue

On Monday, May 19, 2013 at approximately 5:33 pm, San Francisco Police Department requested to review surveillance footage, reporting that a robbery had occurred in front of the ATM machine on Golden Gate Avenue. The UC Hastings surveillance camera was unable to capture the victim, a female adult getting robbed at knifepoint by an unknown male adult wearing a red ball cap.

Suspect fled on foot westbound on Golden Gate Avenue, then northbound onto Larkin Street.

Suspect(s) Description: Unknown

SFPD reported no suspect in custody at this time.
