Theft From Auto – 100 McAllister Street

On May 21, 2013 at approximately 1:23 am UC Hastings student reported to the Office of Public Safety that clothing and toiletries were stolen from their moving truck that was parked in front of the student residential building (100 McAllister Street). The truck was left unattended and the rear gate of the vehicle was left unsecured. There was no forced entry made upon the vehicle.

The value of the property is approximately \$700 USD.

Surveillance footage of the incident captured footage of the incident and identified a suspect.

Suspect Description:

Black male adult wearing a black wool hat, and black jacket.
