## *Vandalism / Possession of Burglary Tools McAllister/Leavenworth Intersection*

On Saturday, May 25, 2013, at approximately 12:58 am, it was observed by a Hastings Public Safety Officer on surveillance camera, a subject breaking the window on a Red Ford Explorer on Leavenworth Street near the intersection of McAllister Street. The Hastings Public Safety Officer responded to the area and detained the subject. The subject was also in possession of burglary tools. The owner of the vehicle arrived on scene and was identified as a UC Hastings Student. San Francisco Police Department arrived on scene and took custody of the subject and booked him into county jail for Vandalism and Possession of Burglary Tools.

### **Vehicle Description:**

Red Ford Explorer

### **Suspect Description:**

Subject #1: black male adult wearing black beanie, black hooded sweatshirt and gray sweat pants.

- Get a good description of the vandal(s) and their vehicle(s).
- Park your car in well-lit areas in designated parking spaces.
