# Theft From Locked Auto 50-100 Block of Leavenworth Street

On Sunday, May 26, 2013 it was reported by a UC Hastings student to the Department of Public Safety that their vehicle's window was broken and items were stolen while it was parked on the 50-100 block of Leavenworth Street between the hours of approximately 1:00 am - 9:30 am.

Small various items, CD's, and cell phone charger were taken from the vehicle with an unknown value.

The vehicle was parked in an area out of campus surveillance camera range.
