Robbery – 200 McAllister/Muni Bus

On Sunday, June 02, 2013 at approximately 10:10pm, a robbery occurred on the #5 Muni Bus in front of 200 McAllister Street bus stop. Unknown male suspect grabbed the victim's cell phone from his hand and ran off the bus. Several juvenile suspects were involved in this robbery. Suspects were last observed fleeing on foot southbound onto Hyde Street. One of the suspects was captured and arrested by Hastings Public Safety Officers. San Francisco Police Department arrived on scene and took custody of the subject and booked him into county jail for robbery.

Suspects Description:

Four black male juveniles.

Personal Robbery Safety Tips:

- Exercise your peripheral vision at all times, and be aware of your surroundings 360 degrees around you.
- If you are faced with demands for your money or property, especially from an armed subject, comply with their demands for the sake of your safety.
- Follow the robber's commands, but do not volunteer help.
- Be observant and plan to be a good witness.
- Try to note the robber's method of escape and direction of travel.
