100 McAllister Street

On Friday, June 8, 2013, at approximately 10:30 am, a UC Hastings student reported that their bicycle was stolen from the 100 McAllister bicycle storage room. The student reported that they left their bicycle locked in the storage room on the afternoon of May 31, 2013 and returned to the room on June 8, 2013 at 9:00am to discover that the bicycle and lock was missing.

Suspect Description: Unknown

Bicycle Description:

Diamond Back Bicycle, Black and Blue in Color, with a UCLA bicycle Registration sticker on it.

Bike Theft Prevention Tips

- Always lock your bike's frame and wheels with a high-quality, modern U-lock (with a disc/flat key)
- Remove all detachable items like lights, bags and quick release parts and take them with you
- Lock to a bike rack, or firmly affixed (bolts covered in concrete) pole.

If you are the victim of a crime in the area of UC Hastings, please report it to Hastings Public Safety Department, and then to San Francisco Police Department to file reports.

If you observe any suspicious activity on or around campus please report it to Campus Public Safety immediately at 565-4611 or by picking up a "Red" phone, or once you are in a safe location.
