Robbery – 200 McAllister/Muni Bus

On Tuesday, June 18, 2013 at approximately 9:58pm, a robbery occurred at the # 19 Polk bus stop on the side of 200 McAllister Street. Unknown male suspect grabbed the victim's cell phone from his hand and ran. Two male suspects were involved in this robbery. Suspects were last observed fleeing on foot eastbound onto Hyde Street. The suspects were not captured.

Suspects Description:

Two black males wearing black hoodies and dark pants.

Personal Robbery Safety Tips:

- Exercise your peripheral vision at all times, and be aware of your surroundings 360 degrees around you.
- If you are faced with demands for your money or property, especially from an armed subject, comply with their demands for the sake of your safety.
- Follow the robber's commands, but do not volunteer help.
- Be observant and plan to be a good witness.
- Try to note the robber's method of escape and direction of travel.
