Grand Theft – 100 McAllister Street

On June 27, 2013 at approximately 10:40 am a member of the UC Hastings community reported to the Office of Public Safety that a laptop computer was determined to be stolen from their residential unit located in the 100 McAllister Street building between 1:30 am -2:00 am.

The value of the computer is approximately \$2,200 and is described as a Macbook Pro 15 inch 2011 model. Serial # C02G7GLHDRJC

One suspect has been identified at this time. The suspect was invited as a guest into the unit.

Suspect Description:

Black Male Adult, 40-50 years of age, large build, wearing a red hooded sweatshirt, and brown pants.
