Grand Theft From Locked Auto 50-100 Block of Leavenworth Street

On Saturday July 6, 2013 it was reported to the Department of Public Safety that while a member of the public was picking up a passenger from 100 McAllister Street building, their vehicle that was parked on the 50-100 block of Leavenworth Street had it's rear driver side window broken and items were stolen while it was parked from 5:00pm – 5:10pm.

Items Reported Stolen:

Small various items, a black messenger bag, laptop computer, and Amazon Kindle.
Total value of items approximately \$1450.00 USD.

The vehicle was parked in an area out of campus surveillance camera range.

Vehicle Description:

Lexus Es 350 – Red in color
