Robbery Attempt - 50 Hyde Street

On Thursday, July 11, 2013, at approximately 09:30 am, it was reported to a Hastings Public Safety Officer that an attempted robbery took place on Hyde Street between McAllister Street and Golden Gate Avenue. The victim stated that he was walking northbound on Hyde Street when an unknown subject attempted to steal his Iphone 4s and a struggle ensued. The victim dropped his keys during the incident and the unknown subject picked the keys up and ran northbound on Hyde Street. The victim ran southbound to seek assistance and contacted a Public Safety Officer.

An area search of the area for the suspect was met with negative results.

Suspect Information:

black male adult, 6'2 - 6'3, 180lbs, wearing a black jacket, blue jeans, white shoes, and a gray beanie

Robbery Safety Tips:

- Exercise your peripheral vision at all times, and be aware of your surroundings 360 degrees around you.
- If you are faced with demands for your money or property, especially from an armed subject, comply with their demands for the sake of your safety.
- Follow the robber's commands, but do not volunteer help.
- Be observant and plan to be a good witness.
- Try to note the robber's method of escape and direction of travel.

At the UC Hastings Garage there are assistance stations that can be used to contact Campus Public Safety as well.
