Vandalism / Theft From Locked Vehicle 50-100 Leavenworth Street

On Monday July 15, 2013 at approximately 07:30 am, a UC Hastings community member reported a vandalism, and theft from their locked vehicle that had occurred while parked on the 50-100 block of Leavenworth Street. The incident occurred between the hours of 10:30 pm July 14, and 07:00 am on today's date. The victim reported that paperwork for the vehicle, and loose change was taken from the vehicle. Additionally the window of the vehicle was broken during the incident.

No suspects have been identified at this time.

Auto Burglary Prevention Tips

- Lock all vehicle doors
- Set alarm or anti-theft device
- Don't leave valuables in the car
- If you must leave valuable items in your car while out and about, place items out of sight before reaching your destination or move them inconspicuously
