## ***Petty Theft – 100 McAllister Street***

On Tuesday, July 23, 2013 at approximately 6:45pm, a UC Hastings student reported that their bicycle was stolen from the 100 McAllister bicycle storage room. The student reported they left their bicycle locked in the room approximately four weeks ago and returned to the room on July 23, 2013 at 6:42pm to discover that the bicycle and lock was missing.

### **Suspect Description: Unknown**

### **Bicycle Description:**

Specialized bicycle, white and brown in color, with a UC Hastings bicycle registration sticker on it.

### **Personal Safety Tips**

- Always lock your bike's frame and wheels with a high-quality, modern U-lock (with a disc/flat key).
- Remove all detachable items like lights, bag and quick release parts and take them with you.
- Lock to a bike rack, or firmly affixed (bolts covered in concrete) pole.
