## ***Petty Theft – 100 McAllister Street***

On Thursday, July 25, 2013 at approximately 2:05pm, a UC Hastings student reported that their bicycle was stolen from the 100 McAllister bicycle storage room. The student reported they left their bicycle in the room July 09, 2013 and returned to the room on July 20, 2013 to discover that the bicycle was missing.

### **Suspect Description: Unknown**

### **Bicycle Description:**

2007 Schwinn bicycle, black in color, 21 speed road bike, with a UC Hastings bicycle registration sticker on it.

### **Personal Safety Tips**

- Always lock your bike's frame and wheels with a high-quality, modern U-lock (with a disc/flat key).
- Remove all detachable items like lights, bag and quick release parts and take them with you.
- Lock to a bike rack, or firmly affixed (bolts covered in concrete) pole.
