***Vandalism/ Theft Attempt
50-100 Leavenworth Street***

On Saturday, July 27, 2013, at approximately 10:00 pm, a member of the public returned to his vehicle that was parked on the west side of Leavenworth Street near McAllister Street to find that the window of the truck was broken, and two unknown suspects were inside the vehicle. An altercation occurred and the victim chased the two unknown suspects south on Leavenworth Street and eastbound onto McAllister Street.

One suspect ran into U.N. Plaza. The San Francisco Police Department was able to apprehend one of the suspects.

Suspect Information:

Suspect #1: Black male adult, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans

Suspect #2: Black male adult, wearing a blue beanie, a gray hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans and carrying a black bag.
