Vandalism/ Theft From Locked Auto 300-400 Golden Gate Avenue

On Friday, July 27, 2013, at approximately 11:00 pm, A UC Hastings Public Safety Officer contacted a member of the public near 350 Golden Gate Avenue where it was observed their vehicle may have been vandalized the night before. Upon contact with the owner it was confirmed that the vehicle had been broken into and a laptop computer was stolen from the vehicle.

Vehicle Description: Grey Chevrolet Malibu

- If you must leave valuable items in your car while out and about, place items out of sight <u>before</u> reaching your destination or move them inconspicuously
