Robbery Attempt - 50 Hyde Street

On Saturday, August 3, 2013, at approximately 10:14 am, it was reported to a Hastings Public Safety Officer that an attempted robbery took place on Hyde Street between McAllister Street and Golden Gate Avenue. The victims that were a family of five stated that they were walking southbound on Hyde Street when an unknown black male suspect attempted to steal their purses and other belongings. A witness observed the incident and a struggle ensued. San Francisco Police arrived shortly after and took the unknown suspect into custody.

Suspect Description:

Black male adult, wearing a black sweatshirt, blue jeans

Robbery Safety Tips:

- Exercise your peripheral vision at all times, and be aware of your surroundings 360 degrees around you.
- If you are faced with demands for your money or property, especially from an armed subject, comply with their demands for the sake of your safety.
- Follow the robber's commands, but do not volunteer help.
- Be observant and plan to be a good witness.
- Try to note the robber's method of escape and direction of travel.

At the UC Hastings Garage there are assistance stations that can be used to contact Campus Public Safety as well.
