Petty Theft – Hyde Street near McAllister Street

On Monday August 5, 2013 at approximately 11:00 am a student reported that he locked his bicycle to a pole and when he returned to retrieve his bicycle it was gone. Surveillance footage of was reviewed with negative results. The bike was parked near the intersection of Hyde and McAllister Street. The student stated that he left his bike at 9:00am and returned at 11:00am to find that it was missing.

Bicycle Description:

Purple colored bike unknown manufacturer valued at \$70.00.

Suspect Description: Unknown

Personal Safety Tips

- Always lock your bike's frame and wheels with a high-quality, modern U-lock (with a disc/flat key).
- Remove all detachable items like lights, bag and quick release parts and take them with you.
- Lock to a bike rack, or firmly affixed (bolts covered in concrete) pole.
