Petty Theft – 100 Block of McAllister Street

On Tuesday, August 20, 2013 at approximately 6:45pm, a person from the general public reported that their bicycle was stolen from in front of 154 McAllister. The victim reported they left their bicycle at 5:30pm and returned at 6:38pm to discover that the bicycle was missing. Victim placed his unlocked bicycle at a parking meter in front of Elmira Café restaurant.

Suspect Description: The suspect was described as a white male adult, approximately 55 years of age, 5'11", 150 lbs. wearing a black sleeveless top, dark colored jeans, with a back pack.

Bicycle Description: Black Mountain bike

Personal Safety Tips

- Always lock your bike's frame and wheels with a high-quality, modern U-lock (with a disc/flat key).
- Remove all detachable items like lights, bag and quick release parts and take them with you.
- Lock to a bike rack, or firmly affixed (bolts covered in concrete) pole.
