Vehicle Burglary, Probation Violation, Possession of Stolen Property 50-100 Leavenworth Street

On Thursday August 22, 2013, at approximately 3:00 pm, San Francisco Police reported to the UC Hastings Department of Public Safety that a Vehicle Burglary occurred on today's date at approximately 01:25 am while parked on the 50-100 block of Leavenworth Street. The suspect was arrested while in possession of stolen property, and on probation for the same type of offense. There were two additional suspects that fled the area on foot with a pressure washer belonging to the victim in the case.

Auto Burglary Prevention Tips

- Lock all vehicle doors
- Set alarm or anti-theft device
- Don't leave valuables in the car
- If you must leave valuable items in your car while out and about, place items out of sight before reaching your destination or move them inconspicuously
