Vandalism / Theft From Locked Auto 50-100 Hyde Street

On Monday August 26, 2013, at approximately 8:30 am, A UC Hastings staff member reported to the UC Hastings Department of Public Safety that a Vehicle appeared to have been vandalized and broken into on the 50-100 block of Hyde Street. At approximately 10:30 am the victim contacted Hastings Public Safety to report that \$25-\$50 USD worth of groceries were stolen from the vehicle.

Surveillance footage of the incident was limited but it appears that the incident occurred at approximately 4:57 am.

No suspects have been identified at this time.

Auto Burglary Prevention Tips

- Lock all vehicle doors
- Set alarm or anti-theft device
- Don't leave valuables in the car
- If you must leave valuable items in your car while out and about, place items out of sight before reaching your destination or move them inconspicuously

At the UC Hastings Garage there are assistance stations that can be used to contact Campus Public Safety as well.
