Petty Theft from Person – Hyde / McAllister Street

On Saturday August 31, 2013 at approximately 12:27 am a member of the public reported that their cellular phone had just been stolen. The victim stated they let an unknown suspect use their phone to make a phone call and the suspect fled on bicycle. The victim chased the suspect through UN Plaza and was last seen on Golden Gate Avenue and Hyde Street. The San Francisco Police Department responded to the scene and handled the investigation.

Phone Description:

iPhone 5 64GB valued at \$500.00.

Suspect Description:

The suspect remains at large.

The victim described the unknown suspect as a black / asian male, in mid 20's, approximately 6'2, 210 pounds, shoulder length dreadlocks, wearing gray sweatshirt, light colored "San Francisco" hat, gray sweats, blue and gray Nike shoes and riding a bicycle.
