Grand Theft – 0-50 Hyde Street

On Thursday, September 12, 2013, at approximately 1:05 pm, it was reported to a Hastings Public Safety Officer that a bicycle theft took place on Hyde Street between McAllister Street and Golden Gate Avenue. The victim reported that they parked their bicycle and locked it to a parking sign at 10:30 am and returned at 1:00 pm and found that the bicycle was gone.

Surveillance footage review of an area near the location revealed a suspect pushing the bicycle northbound on foot at approximately 12:11 pm.

Bicycle Description:

Specialized 27 Speed, Gray/Silver, Valued at \$1,000.00

Suspect Description:

White male adult, red baseball cap, wearing a black shirt, blue jeans, 5'7", 165lbs, approximately 25-30 years of age.

Bike Theft Prevention Tips:

- Always lock your bike's frame and wheels with a high-quality, modern U-lock (with a disc/flat key).
- Remove all detachable items like lights, bag and quick release parts and take them with you.
- Lock to a bike rack, or firmly affixed (bolts covered in concrete) pole.
