Vandalism of Vehicle – 200 McAllister Street

On Sunday February 24, 2013 at approximately 6:20 PM, a UC Hasting student reported that their vehicle was vandalized on February 23, 2013 between the hours of 6:45 PM – 10:15 PM while parked on the 200 block of McAllister Street. The victim's vehicle had its front passenger tire intentionally slashed with an unknown sharp instrument.

There was no surveillance footage of the area, and no suspects have been identified.
