## *Petty Larceny/Theft – 100 McAllister Street*

On March 17, 2013 at approximately 3:30 pm it was reported to the Office of Public Safety that a chair was stolen from on the 4<sup>th</sup> floor Rm 413 of the 100 McAllister Street . The victim brought the chair to the room and left it unattended from 11:00am-11:30am and when he returned the chair was missing.

The chair is described as an executive high black chair.
