Once all required documents are received, we can prepare your DS-2019 form and mail it to you. You will need your DS-2019 form to apply for a J-1 student visa at the U.S Embassy in your home country. The processing time for these visas can be long. Please return these forms to the International and Graduate Programs office as soon as possible to be sure to get your visa in time.
