The Thomas Franck Merit Scholarship was created to recognize the extraordinary academic and professional achievements of the late Thomas Franck. Only one LL.M. student per year will be awarded this prestigious full-tuition scholarship. All applicants are eligible to apply, but you must fill out this application in order to be considered. In order to qualify for this scholarship, you must submit a letter from your law school stating that you completed your first degree in law in the top 10% of your class.

Submit your complete application and apply for the scholarship by **February 1** to be considered for this scholarship. The decision will be made after March 1.

NOTE: UC Hastings must receive your completed application from LSAC by no later than February 1. It can take weeks for LSAC to evaluate transcripts and process TOEFL scores. Please plan accordingly. Your application will NOT be considered complete, even if you have already submitted all documents to LSAC, if we have not received your completed application from LSAC.
